- Thank you to those who donated poinsettias for the sanctuary this Christmas. You may take your plants home after worship today.

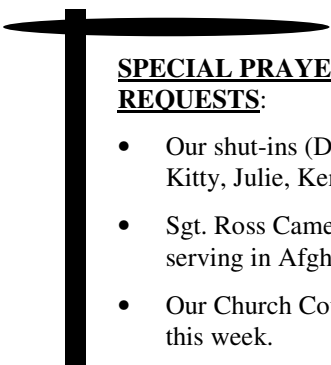
Time and Talents Survey

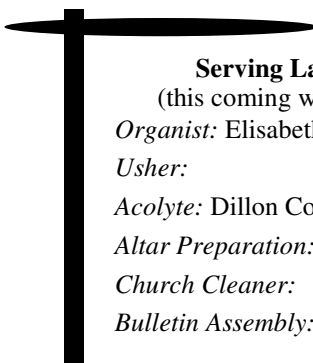

A Thought from the Word

Isaiah 60:1-6

In the Eastern Church the festival of the Epiphany of our Lord is the big celebration, not Christmas. Sadly, it tends to be the forgotten festival among us. This year we have a special opportunity to celebrate it since it falls on a Sunday. Isaiah uses beautiful picture language to show us why this festival is so important. He foretold that the Savior would not just be for the people of Israel, but for the whole world. That includes you and me. That good news of a Savior guides and directs everything that we do.
