A Thought from the Word

Mark 2:23-28

As you drive or ride along this week, pay attention to stop signs. Watch how other drivers react to a stop sign. Some drivers will do what police call on tickets a “rolling stop.” They will slow down, but never come to a complete stop. At creation God gave us a stop sign. It was called the “Sabbath,” which in Hebrew means “rest.” It was designed for Old Testament believers to be not just a day you rolled through but a day where you would come to a complete stop. Jesus put aside the Old Testament practice but we are to still honor the Sabbath by regularly taking time to be in the Word and to worship. It’s a temptation in our busy world to let this fall down the list of priorities, and without God’s Word the worries of the world begin to weigh heavily on us. Through all that Jesus accomplished, however, we have rest from our worries and a guarantee of peace with God. So enjoy your Sabbath rest—it’s a blessing from God!
