A Thought from the Word

Pentecost 8

Amos 7:10-15

Jeroboam II of Israel followed in the sins of Jeroboam I even though he lived a century and a half later. Chief among those sins was golden calf worship at Bethel and Dan. God sent Amos to preach the downfall of Israel and Jeroboam II because of such sins. Amaziah, prophet at the false altar in Bethel, ordered Amos out of Israel and back to Judah. Amaziah wanted Amos to "earn his bread" there and "prophesy" there. It is interesting that the false prophet begrudged God's true prophet the money he made as a prophet as much as he begrudged the message of Amos. We do not begrudge the money given to those who preach God's Word. We gladly give our offerings to support the proclamation of the gospel among us.
