A Thought from the Word

Pentecost 6

2 Corinthians 8:1-9, 13-14

What does it mean to be rich? Today's reading is a classic Scripture lesson on giving. But before we can be about the business of giving, we have to be good at receiving, and we don't always do that very well. The Macedonians, held up as an example by Paul, understood the depth of God's love for them. They recognized their riches through Christ. Now he reminds the Corinthians of what Jesus did for them: "For your sakes he became poor, so that you, through his poverty, might become rich." When we consider what Christ gave up to come to earth, and what he suffered for us on the cross, God's love becomes evident. In receiving this love, we become rich beyond measure, for there is no price we can put on the gift of eternal life. In response to such generous giving, we also learn to give generously.
