## A Thought from the Word

### Pentecost 10

John 6:24-35

“The squeaky wheel gets the grease” is a phrase in our culture that defines importance. How do you determine what is important? Is it the same way that God determines what is important? How attuned are we as God’s children to knowing and acting on what God considers important? In our reading, the crowds were seeking Jesus according to their own definition of what was important. They followed him for his miracles and because he fed them. When you give your time and finances to the church, is it for the right reason? In the Old Testament, when people brought sacrifices to the Lord’s altar, their attitude was that they brought them with no strings attached. They simply turned the offerings over to the Lord for his use. Some were burned; some went to feed the priests and the Levites. When we bring our offerings to the Lord, are we willing to let them go and be used in service as the Lord directs, or do we want to keep some control over their use? In the right attitude, let God determine the priority in the use of our gifts. Then we will be giving for the right reasons.
