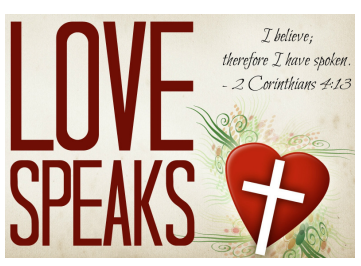

Hebrews 13:1-8
