Pentecost 10

John 6:1-15—Your gifts to the church can be multiplied in service to the Lord. Often this takes the form of “matching funds.” A donor, a foundation, or an insurance company may step forward and challenge congregation members to support a cause with their gifts, and then matching funds are used to increase the final total. But look what happens when Jesus gets involved: the gifts are multiplied beyond anyone's expectation. A boy's lunch feeds thousands. How can this be? It's God's math. We like to subtract and divide. We seem to look at only what is left, or how it is going to be divided to support so many needs. But God likes to add and multiply.
