3. After seeing the movie, how would you explain to someone why Jesus had to suffer and die?

4. If you were one of the disciples on the road talking with Jesus right now, what would you still want to ask him?

5. John wrote at the end of his gospel, "*Jesus did many other miraculous signs in the presence of his disciples, which are not recorded in this book. But these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name*" (John 20:30-31). What do we need to remember about the purpose of the Scriptures, as we wrestle with these questions and as we share our faith with others?

6. Before Jesus ascended into heaven, he told his disciples, “*You will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth*” (Acts 1:8). With the apostles, “*we cannot help speaking about what we have seen and heard*” (Acts 4:20). How do you feel better equipped as a witness after seeing the movie? How might you use the movie itself as you witness?
