

## “Thought for this Week”



### Read Habakkuk 1:1-3; 2:1-4

As we read the opening verses from Habakkuk where he questions why there is so much injustice and why those who are evil seem to have it so good, you almost

wonder if he is our contemporary. What he writes could easily be asked by us today. And just as the problem expressed by Habakkuk is relevant to us, so is the Lord’s answer. He says judgment day is coming. On that day all those who have done evil will get what they deserve, “but the righteous will live by his faith.” What comfort! And what a reminder! The great-

est thing we can do until judgment day is use the resources that God gives us to share the faith that saves. Let us not grow tired from the evil and the seeming misappropriation of riches in the world around us, but let us tirelessly share the gospel with all the resources we have so that those who are evil may repent and be saved—just like us!
