In the Old Testament
Passover meal, a year old
spotless lamb was
slaughtered. Its blood was
painted on the door posts all
in accordance with God's
command. Trusting in God,
the Israelites followed these
instructions and the Angel
of Death passed over their
houses and they were saved.
All of this was a picture
pointing forward to Jesus,
the spotless and sinless Son
of God.

On Calvary, Jesus shed his blood in our place to pay for all our sins! Because of his perfect sacrifice, the



gates of heaven are open for all who believe! This is why Jesus alone is worthy of the angels' praises as well as yours and mine!

The best part is that you don't have to wait until heaven to join in praising Jesus. Each week we gather to worship Jesus and sing his praises. Each day you give glory to Jesus as you read the Bible. 
