

*Read Ecclesiastes 1:2:  
2:18-26.*

“You can't take it with you.” This is a universal truth. To that sentiment we might also add, “And you can't be certain of what is going to

happen to what you leave behind.” Solomon was acutely aware of both of these truths. From a good and gracious God he'd received “wealth, riches, and honor such as no king before or after him” (2 Chronicles 1:12). Solomon however, was brought to the understanding that there is a vast difference between

life apart from Christ, which is meaningless, and life with Christ, which is full. God is the giver of all good gifts, and he forgives when we repent of our reliance on things instead of Jesus. Though we can't take it with us, when Jesus returns, he will take us, together with all believers, to be with him forever.
